HOUSING

Bunkhouse: has bunk beds with community bathrooms and two counselor's room with private bathroom. (Linens are not provided.)

FAMILY AND CAMPERS: Each family/camper will have their own room/s. If your family is 4 people or larger you will be assigned adjoining and/or rooms next to each other.

CREW: You will have a roommate according to gender and age. If you have not already requested a specific roommate and wish to do so, please let us know as soon as possible. Each crew member will have their own bed.

MEALS & SPECIAL TREATS

All meals are provided, including beverage and dessert. Various treats will be available during certain events. All breakfasts, lunch and a most dinners are served in the cafeteria. We will have one special catered dinner served during an evening themed event in the meeting space.

Cold drink machines are located at the end of the hotels and in front of the Maple Fellowship Center. A snack machine is located inside the Maple Fellowship Center as well as a gift shop that has some treats for sale. Ice machines are in the middle hallway of each hotel and in the hallway of the Raintree Center.
